Chapter 1: The Mitzvos

Number of Mitzvos:

There are a total of **51** Mitzvos in Parshas Kedoshim; **13** positive commands and **38** negative commands. The following are the commands in the chronological order that they are brought in the Parsha.

A. Positive:

1. **Mitzvah 212; Positive 92:** To fear ones father and mother
2. **Mitzvah 213; Positive 93:** To leave the corner of one's field to the poor [i.e. Peiah]

2. Punishment for Shifcha Charufa:

- One who sleeps with a Shifcha Charufa is not to be killed.
- He is to bring an Asham to the Ohel.

Shelishi:

3. Mitzvah of Arla and Neta Rivai

- When the Jewish people come to Eretz Yisrael and you plant fruit trees, the fruits of the first three years are Arla and are forbidden to be eaten.
- In the fourth year the fruits are to be Kodesh Hilulim, fruits of praise for Hashem.
- In the fifth year you may eat the fruit.
- The above Mitzvah was given to add in your grain

1. Don't eat on the blood

Revi'i:

Chamishi:

5. Punishment of Molech:

- Tell the Jewish people that if anyone gives their child to Molech they will be stoned to death.
- The man will be cut off from his nation as he gave his child to Molech in order to defile my Temple and desecrate my name.
- If the people will ignore the man and ignore giving him his due punishment I myself will cut off him and his family as well as all the other followers of Molech

6. List of punishments:

1. One who visits the Ov or Yidoni and follows them will be cut off from his nation. You are to be holy as I am Hashem your G-d.

Shishi:

2. You are to guard my commands and perform them, I am Hashem your G-d.
3. One who curses his father and mother is to be killed.
4. One who sleeps with a married women both are to be killed
5. One who sleeps with his father's wife has revealed his father's Erva, both are to be killed
6. One who sleeps with his daughter in-law have done Tevel and both are to be killed
7. One who sleeps with a male have done an abomination, both are to be killed
8. One who sleeps with his mother in-law have done Zima, they are to be killed
9. A man who sleeps with an animal both are to be killed
10. A women who sleeps with an animal, both are to be killed
11. One who sleeps with his sister have done Chesed, both will be cut off from their nation, as he has revealed his sisters Erva.
12. One who sleeps with a Nida, if he has performed Hearah, both will be cut off from their nation.
13. One may not sleep with his aunt, both will carry their sin. One who sleeps with his aunt, they will both die without children.
14. One who sleeps with his brother's wife has committed Nida, both will die childless.
15. One is to guard all of My commandments and perform them and in this way the land of Israel will not repel you

Shevi'i

7. Final Mitzvos and tidings:

- Do not walk in the statutes of the gentiles, as I have despised them. I have inherited their lands to you, a land of milk and honey. I am Hashem your G-d that has separated you from the nations.
- You shall distinguish between the pure and impure animals and birds.
- You shall not defile your souls with eating these forbidden animals and birds and the creeping creatures.
- You are to be holy to me as I am holy and I have separated you from the nations so you be mine.
- A man or woman who is an Ov or Yidoni will be killed through stoning.
